I did suggest that as long as they know the rules and they are the "Person in charge" that day, then what they say goes. The person shouldn't necessarily have to be an on field referee.</li> <li>Tash to look into signage 'this is a game' etc</li> <li>Email reminder to team coaches and managers regarding parents on opposite side of bench, manage parent behaviour and possibly penalties</li> <li>Referees and shadow referees to have official uniform</li> </ul>

	U18s Aus tourney prep:	
	This is now waiting on a response from NZL who wish to make it NZ teams instead of regional teams, because the boys are going as NZ. However it won't be true to past NZL selection rules as both regions have already selected coaching and management staff and Waikato have already pre selected players based on their performance at NZ nationals this year. So there will be more info forthcoming	

	from them this week apparently. Also the tournament may be moving to Brisbane instead of Adelaide, waiting on response from LA after their board meeting last week.	
	Club league:	
	After an awful lot of information gathering, I have got the leagues set up on FM and draws are done.	
	Women - 7 A division teams, 4 B division teams, 4 C division teams (including putaruru College year 7s and 8s who did not register for intermediate league so I have popped them in there.)	
	Men - usual 4 teams	
	Discussion with Maree today about the fee structure, we have set the girls fees as \$250 for A and B div and \$230 for C div. I have informed the clubs they will then be billed the NZL fee of \$25pp for their senior players (over 18) only separately, as the HS players have already paid.	
	For the boys the fees are set at \$450 per team which includes the NZL fee. The boys tend to just work out who is reffing between them and don't do reimbursements, would rather have their team fees low, so they only need to pay some admin/operations costs like storage, and the rest is their NZL fees built in. All the teams seem to have a pretty good split of Senior and junior players so we discussed that it seems easier to bill them as one and then there is no hassle of chasing as boys tend to be worse at this.	
	Term 1 sixes:	
	I sent out a registration of interest form which went out to all current schools and a couple of new/old ones. So far I boys and 2 girls schools have registered interest which is exciting! I have asked for them to get back to me by the end of the month so I can start putting together what the league will look like and cost before they break up in December. Need to confirm that the mens and womens senior teams	
	are happy to run them as fundraisers for their senior nationals campaigns alongside the club sixes that they want to organise and play in like last year. Couple of interested girls from Kaipaki and Suburbs.
