Responsibilities and Duties

- Have input into the Representative Programme Policy and structure (reviewed annually).
- Provide input into the Representative Player Selection Policy (reviewed annually).
- Set the Representative Programme direction.
- Stay informed about the Representative Programme Policy and related documents to ensure all staff are working within this Policy.
- Collaborate with the other Representative Head Coach (RHC).
- Mentor Team Coaches.
- Create a team trial structure for selection for all Representative Teams.
- Be part of the Selection Panel for Representative Teams.
- Work with the Representative Head Manager (RHM) to ensure appropriate training venues are sourced.
- Work with the RHM to ensure appropriate flights, accommodation and transport are sourced.
- Compile a report at the end of each programme.
- Provide clear and professional communication with and between clubs, schools, coaches, managers, players, parents and any other member as required.
- Contribute to the WLA being viewed as a professional, well run and forward-thinking organisation.
- Be a role model and provide positive leadership.
- Stay informed about the Health and Safety Policy and any procedures, and take further action if you notice something unsafe.
- Evaluate personal performance.
- Follow all aspects of the WLA code of conduct, policies and regulations.
- Any other duty related to the role.
